

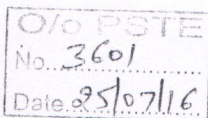
**Subject:- Haryana Resident Certificate-regarding admission in educational institutions (including medical and technical institutions).**

Will the Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Haryana, Higher Education Department and Principal Secretary to Government Haryana, Technical Education Department, kindly refer to the subject noted above?

2. The attention of Administrative Departments is invited towards para 3 of the Govt. letter No. 62/17/95-6GS1, dated 3.10.1996 which provides that "Candidate seeking admission in Educational Institutions (including Medical and Technical Institutions) located in Haryana, may not be required to produce Resident Certificate, if they have passed the last examination from a school/college situated in Haryana. For this purpose a certificate of the Principal/Headmaster from concerned institution where the children/wards studies last should be considered sufficient. The principal/Headmaster of the institution shall be competent to issue such certificate which should be sufficient."

3. They are, therefore, requested to issue directions to the Educational Institutions (including Medical and Technical Institutions) that the candidates seeking admission in educational institutions may not be asked to produce Resident Certificate, if they have passed the last examination from a school/college situated in Haryana as per proviso of para 3 of Govt. letter No. 62/17/95-6GS1, dated 3.10.1996.
