## **PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING VOCATIONAL COURSES UNDER NSQF**

***Procedure for processing online applications for seeking approval for introduction of Vocational Education programmes leading to Degree or Diploma in Vocational Education under National Skill Qualification Framework.***

1. Only AICTE approved Institutions are eligible to apply.
2. Institution willing to run Vocational Education Courses should have AICTE approval in relevant area.
3. In the AY 2018-19 institute can apply upto 100 seats from given specialization, with a division size of 25 each. Institute may choose one specialization with 04 division OR 04 specializations with 01 division of each specialization OR any other similar combination.

## **5. Procedure for processing application**

- Existing Institution will apply for VE programme on AICTE Portal and select the available Sectors/Specialization from Portal.
- A two members Scrutiny Committee shall verify the eligibility of Institution for the programme and give its recommendation for intake in applied sector and specialization based on available facility in the Institution. Copy of Scrutiny Sheet is attached as **Annexure-I**.
- Opportunity will be given for re-scrutiny, in case of deficiency noted by the scrutiny Committee.
- The composition of Scrutiny Committee shall be one member from sector Skill Council/ Industrial Association and one academician.
- Regional Scrutiny Committee report will be placed before the respective Regional Committee.
- Recommendation of Regional Committee shall be forwarded to HQ's for further processing.
- The final approval of Council will be communicated along with the EOA for 2018-19.

## **6. Admission Procedure, Curriculum and Fees:**

- The Institution shall publish in their brochure & website the details of this scheme and the specialization offered along with the approved intake.
- The institute shall also display the tuition and other fees charged by the institute for these specialization on their brochure & website.
- The Institution can invite applications by giving advertisement in newspapers and publishing the same in the Institution's website.
- These courses may be affiliated with existing University or any Skill University/ National University having jurisdiction for affiliation.
- The Procedure, Rules and Regulations for admission shall be as prescribed by the affiliating University or Board of Technical Education.
- The Institution shall display information regarding admitted candidates in their website for information to the students and other stakeholders.
- Admission of students to these seats shall be done on merit basis as per the State Reservation Policy. Admissions will be done as per the academic calendar prescribed by AICTE in APH 2018-19.
- Unfilled seats of reserve category may be converted to open category.
- Curriculum for such courses will be as prescribed by Board of Technical Education/ University of respective state. Model curriculum is given by AICTE.
- Education component will be taught by the institute and the skill component will be covered by SKP/ Training Provider approved by NSDC or Govt. Agency.
- The SKP must be located near the vicinity of college.
- The classes may be offered in flexi hours by the institute.

## 7. Assessment and Certification

- University/Board will conduct examination for Education Component.
- SKP/Training Provider will do assessment for skill competency.
- The Skill Knowledge Provider/Trainers (SKP) will submit the Necessary skill credits of the students to the institute where student is registered.
- Both these credits will be transferred to the Technical Board or the University as the case may be, which compiles the Vocational Skill credits and the formal education credits and if all such credits are available as required by the certification level, then the Technical Board or the University shall award the certification of that level.
- Credit calculation and certification will be as per SAMVAY, the skill credit framework notified by MHRD.

**No separate requirement means :-** requirement shall be met with existing infrastructure/ facilities in the Institution for conduct of Programmes under consideration.

## 19.1 Counselling/ admission

- Last date to grant approval to Technical Institution shall be 30<sup>th</sup> April of each Calendar Year. Notwithstanding anything contained in any Rules, Regulations, Norms and Standards, Policies, Instructions, Orders, Notifications, Guidelines and the Approval Process Handbook 2018-19 issued or notified by the AICTE, the AICTE shall not grant approval to Technical Institution after 30<sup>th</sup> April of the Calendar Year in which the academic session is to commence as any approval beyond 30<sup>th</sup> April shall adversely affect the total teaching duration to which a student is entitled to and shall also adversely affect the academic activities which shall be prejudicial to the academic interest of student.
- The respective DTE/ State Government/ UT/ Affiliating University/ Board shall download the list of approved Institutions along with "Approved Intake" from Web-Portal through their login. No separate communication shall be sent in this regard. The Affiliating body such as University/ Board shall not grant affiliation to a Technical Institution approved by AICTE after 15<sup>th</sup> May of the Calendar Year in which the academic session is to commence.
- The Competent Authority for admission shall ensure that the First round of counselling/ admission for allotment of seats is duly completed on or before 30<sup>th</sup> June of the Calendar Year in which the academic session is to commence.
- Provided that the Second round of counselling/ admission for allotment of seats shall be completed on or before 10<sup>th</sup> July of the Calendar Year in which the academic session is to commence.
- Further that the last round of counselling/ admission for allotment of seats shall be completed on or before 20<sup>th</sup> July of the Calendar Year in which the academic session is to commence.
- Notwithstanding anything contained in these Regulations, all Technical Institutions conducting Post Graduate Diploma Courses shall not initiate admission process before 1<sup>st</sup> April of the Academic Year.

- 19.2 The academic session and the teaching process shall commence on 1<sup>st</sup> August of the year (except for PGDM).
